Administrative/Biographical History

Biographical note on Archibald Lacy Camp III

Archibald Lacy Camp III was born on March 14, 1876 to Archibald Lacy Camp Jr. and Carrie Camp in Covington, Georgia. Archibald's family moved to Greeley, Colorado when he was a young child. When he was older, he taught music including instruction for the mandolin. On October 12, 1902, Archibald married Marie Johanna Puttkammer, a former music student. Together the couple lived in Boulder, Colorado where he owned a music store. The couple had one son, Archibald Carl Camp, on June 21, 1908. Archibald was a renowned banjo player and also penned *Uncle Charley and His Rifle*. Archibald died on April 26, 1968 in Boulder.

Scope and Content

Consists of family photographs and documents from Archibald Lacy Camp III; the banjo and mandolin that he played with various supplies, including strings and picks; a trunk that traveled from the United States to Hawaii; a shaving mug used by Archibald Lacy Camp III; and suspenders given to Archibald from Marie.

Consists of a blank page with letterhead from Archibald Lacy Camp III's music store in Boulder.

Series VII: Obituary

Consists of an obituary for Archie C. Camp.

Series VIII: Biography

Consists of a biography on Ichabod Camp.

Series IX: Genealogy

Consists of a genealogy on Margaret Camp Fields' family through her great-great grandparents.

Series X: Record Album

Consists of one vinyl record of Archibald Lacy Camp III playing banjo.
