Administrative/Biographical History

Biographical note on Jeannette Senier Noxon

Jeannette Senier Noxon was born on May 24, 1876 to Avah Camp and John H. Senier in Covington, Georgia. In 1878, she and her parents moved from Georgia to Greeley, Colorado. While living in Greeley she took an interest in civic affairs and was a member of the First Congregational Church, Garden City Chapter No. 3, Order of the Eastern Star, the Social Order of the Beauceant, Centennial Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, and the Union Colony Pioneer Society. Jeannette also worked at the Greeley Tribune for eight years as the head bookkeeper. She was married to Aury B. Noxon and together they had one son, Charles A. Noxon. Jeannette died on August 6, 1968 in Greeley.
