The Fortnightly Music Club was founded by ten local women in 1907. The charter members included Katie Bullock, Louise Bunker, Katherine Darby, Lucy Delbridge, Alice Doane, Eva Earle, Blanche Hughes, Elizabeth Kendel, Mary Shattuck, and Edith Strong. These women wanted to stimulate musical interest in the citizens of Greeley as well as develop the talent of its members. The early years of the club saw musicians of national and international fame come to Greeley. Along with famous musicians, members of the club would, and still do, work and perform with the Greeley Philharmonic Orchestra.
