Originally from Buenos Aires, Argentina, the Gillespie family migrated to Greeley, Colorado in the late nineteenth century. The patriarch of the family, Alec, started working at the Bank of Greeley and worked his way up to assume the role of president of the company. Over the years, the Gillespie family increased in size and contributed to society in numerous ways.
