Originating in 1926, The Greeley Garden Club was one of the largest gardening clubs in the state of Colorado. The gardening club also collaborated with other clubs such as the Greeley Morning Gardening Club and often held annual gardening tours for enthusiasts and newcomers. Many of their tours were sponsored by nursing associations such as the University Of Northern Colorado School Of Nursing Emeritus Faculty in which the club offered nursing scholarships and education.

The collection contains newspaper articles, magazines, correspondence and thank you cards, registry of members, and lists of meetings and times from 1979 to 1982. Thank you notes often come from various hospitals and even some of the members expressing their gratitude towards the Greeley Gardening Club.
