### Administrative/Biographical History

The Greeley Woman's Club began on March 15, 1920 with Lynn McMullen as president. On March 26<sup>th</sup>, 1920 the Articles of Incorporation was written by Nanna Wright, Verta Ewing, Mae Cross, Dorothy Finley, Myrtle Neill, Agnes Bonell, Ettelle Kelly and Mary Wood. At that time there were thirty five charter members, many of whom had been members of the Pioneer Club of Greeley. In 1921 the club affiliated with the General Federation of Women's Clubs. The purpose of the Club was to contribute intellectually, musically and socially to the community of Greeley.

### Scope and Content

Records of the Greeley Woman's Club containing board of director's meeting minutes, general meeting minutes, club reports, officer and committee documents, photographs, certificates, a history booklet, guest books, bylaws, yearbooks and ledgers.
