Administrative/Biographical History

J.E. Snook (1861-1958), long time Greeley resident served as County Clerk during WWI, later as Weld County Superintendent of Schools, and still later as custodian of safety deposit vaults at First National Bank. He was an active member of both the Park Congregational Church and the Colorado Odd Fellows.

Scope and Content

Collection contains photos, letters, newspaper clippings, poetry, and miscellaneous printed materials pertaining to James Eugene Snook. Photos include immediate and extended family. Most letters are from J.E. Snook to various individuals, including grandson James Otto Snook. Newspaper clippings primarily detailing J.E. Snook's 96th birthday and employment at First National Bank as custodian of the safety deposit vault, as well as various obituaries, including one of his son Harry Snook, and one of Edith Heath.
