Administrative/Biographical History

The first Masonic meeting in the region that became Colorado took place in 1858. By 1858, due to the discovery of gold in Gilpin County, many Masons had arrived and they were determined to form a new Masonic lodge. In June of that year, a committee of three obtained a block of ground, and in a matter of weeks, they held a meeting of over 200 Masons at what is presumed to be the first "Masonic Temple" between the Missouri River and the Pacific Coast. In 1861, the federal government officially recognized the Territory of Colorado, and in that year, the Grand Lodge of Colorado (Ancient, Free, and Accepted Masons) was formed.

In <u>Greeley</u>: In 1870, a group of Greeley Masons was granted a dispensation to operate a lodge. The charter was granted on September 26, 1871, to Occidental Lodge No. 20. The Lodge occupied six distinct locations during its development, the cornerstone for the Greeley Masonic Temple having been laid in 1927.

To satisfy the demands of a growing population, the Masons also established a presence outside Greeley. The <u>Windsor</u> Lodge No. 69 was instituted in 1887 and operated independently until 1986, when it was consolidated with Occidental Lodge #20.

The Masonic Lodge in <u>Eaton</u> was formed in 1899 and chartered in 1900, under the name of Abdallah Lodge No. 109. In 1906, its name was changed to Eaton Lodge No. 109. The Eaton Lodge never had a Temple of its own, meeting instead in rented quarters.

In 2015, the Masonic Temple in Greeley was sold, and the group merged with the Masonic Lodge in Fort Collins.

Scope and Content

This collection contains meeting minutes, financial records, photographs, correspondence, member registers, visitor logs, and legal documents that chronicle the history of Freemasonry in and around Greeley, Colorado from the 1870s to about 2000. Most materials are from Greeley's Occidental Lodge (A.F. & A.M.) No. 20, Windsor Lodge No. 69, and the Eaton/Abdallah Lodge No. 109. In addition, there are some ledgers, minutes, and other records from Greeley Chapter No. 13 of the Royal Arch Masons, (R.A.M.) Knights Templar, and Hiram Council No. 7 (Royal and Select Masters) in Eaton.
