Administrative/Biographical History

Millard "Skeets" Darwin Calvin (1916-1999), life-long Greeley area resident. Raised on family farm near Kuner. Began photography career in Greeley at Gardner Studio about 1940. Joined U.S. Army Air Force (76th Bomber Squadron 1st Air Corps) March 11, 1942. Photographer for the Army Air Force during World War II serving in both Europe and the Pacific. Honorable discharge 1946. Post-war career: photo journalist for Greeley Tribune 1946-1950; Greeley Rodeo photographer 1950-1975; campus photographer for Colorado State College (CSC) 1956; photo journalist Greeley Journal 1968-1975; freelance photographer 1976-1999; photography show 1992. Married Juanita Goodwin-Cain 1948 and adopted Larry Cain, Juanita's son from a previous marriage, about 1949. Unknown date of divorce. Married Loretta Ann Droesler 1956. Received GED 1952. Member of Greeley VFW Post 2121 1946-1999 and commander 1954-1965, 1984/85, and 1990/91. Member of several various outdoor clubs. Relevant other employment: Bartender at Dutch's 1971 and Swamper at Roasty's 1980-1999.

Carol Rein Shwayder (1931-2010), long-time resident of Greeley, Colorado. Produced multivolume publication titled "Weld County Old and New" on the history and people/families of Weld County.

JoAnna Luth Stull (1955-), Weld County resident since 1981 and friend and fellow genealogist of Carol Rein Shwayder. She worked at Kersey as the Interim Town and Court Clerk in 1999. JoAnna worked as interpretive staff at the City of Greeley Museums from 1994-1996 and came on as regular staff in August of 1999. She became Registrar for the Museums in 2005.

Scope and Content

Photographs, negatives, slides and documents related to the photography career and personal photography pursuits of Skeets Calvin. Major topics include images taken during World War II while Calvin was oversees in Europe and the Pacific; buildings and events in Weld County or that affected Weld County, such as water projects in Larimer County; personal vacation trips; and portrait photography in various settings, weddings, businesses, homes, etc.

Arrangement Folders were divided into broad topics of "Events," "Places," and

"People." Material types are kept together under these topics. Items alphabetized according to subtitle and then to the topical title of the folder. People's names are alphabetized by last name when present. When known, creator's titles for folders were utilized. 3-D objects have been removed

and stored with other 3-D materials.

Subseries J: WWII

Materials related to Skeets's service in World War II, including images that he took.

Series II: People

Archival materials that are primarily significant for the person or people being documented, which includes mainly portrait photography in various settings.

Subseries A: Family

Images related to family groups, excluding portrait photography

Subseries B: Groups

Images of groups of people, excluding families

Subseries C: Portrait

Portrait photography images taken by Skeets, primarily commissioned work

Series III: Places

Archival materials that are primarily significant for the location they document, which includes elements of nature, businesses, and towns.

Subseries A: Colorado

Images taken of locations in the state of Colorado, but outside of Greeley, Colorado.

Subseries B: Greeley

Images taken of location in Greeley, Colorado other than those focused on business locations

Subseries C: Greeley Businesses

Principal subject matter is of the locations of businesses that were located in Greeley, Colorado at the time the image was taken

Subseries D: Nature

Principal subject matter is related to various elements of the natural world

Subseries E: Outside Colorado

Locations are outside the state of Colorado

Principal subject matter is related to modes of transportation
