### Administrative/Biographical History

#### **Brief History on the Union Colony Civic Center**

The Union Colony Civic Center was built between August 7, 1986, when there was a ground breaking ceremony, and September 15, 1989. The project was contracted out to Hensel Phelps Construction Company. The project came to fruition thanks to the fund drive initiated by the Northern Colorado Foundation that raised over \$4,000,000 for the project. After placing two proposals on the ballot that failed in 1975 and 1979, a June 1986 special election saw the proposal passed for the theater and Recreation Center. The building stands on the site of the old Meeker School that was torn down in 1922. The UCCC has two theaters, one named Monfort and the other Hensel Phelps, as well as the Tointon Art Gallery. The Recreation Center was also built at the same time and is attached to the north side of the building.

### Scope and Content

Consists of photographs, negatives, newspapers, programs, publications, and invitations surrounding events at the Union Colony Civic Center. Several stages of the construction of the

building were extensively photographed along with several of the first events and the fundraising for the building. Seasonal programs for the events at the UCCC range from 1988-2004.

**System of arrangement** Order imposed by material type and subject. Original order maintained within scrapbook.

**Conditions governing access** There are no restrictions on the access of this collection.

**Conditions governing reproduction and use** There are no restrictions on the use or reproduction of this collection.
