Administrative/Biographical History

Biographical note of Sidney Lincoln Baldrige

Sidney Lincoln Baldrige was born on July 24, 1910 in Eaton, Colorado to Walter Norman and Callie Lincoln Baldrige. Sidney graduated from Eaton High School in 1929. He then attended Colorado State University and the University of Northern Colorado. Sidney married Velda B. Clark in Loveland on September 10, 1939; the couple did not have any children. The couple moved to Greeley in 1943. Sidney owned Baldrige Hatchery in Greeley. Sidney worked as a chemical analyst for the Great Western Sugar Company. Sidney was one of the founders of the Northern Colorado Gladiolus Society (est. 1955); he served as a chairman for the society. Sidney left the Great Western Sugar Company in 1967 to go into the gladiolus flower growing business. He introduced a new variety of gladiolus, the "Velda B.", named after his wife. Sidney was passionate about growing gladiolus flowers and established the "Gladiolus Festival" which was a yearly summer event at the University of Northern Colorado's James A. Michener Library starting in 1985. In addition, he also established a Gladiolus Hall of Fame and archives at Michener Library. Sidney was on the North American Gladiolus Council Constitutional Review Committee and was president of Commercial Growers Division. He also served as president of the All-America Gladiolus Selection Inc., edited "Bulb Buyer's Guide," was a NAGC accredited judge, and received a NAGC gold medal in 1972 and their achievement award

in 1988. In 1990 he was inducted into the Hall of Fame he established. He was a long time member of St. Gabriel's Anglican Church and active in Mended Hearts and was an early editor of its newsletter. Sidney passed away at the age of 88 in Greeley on March 16, 1999.

Scope and Content

This collection consists of various items from Sidney Baldrige and his wife, Velda. The collection contains photographs, Abstract of Assessments, programs about agriculture and gardening events, booklets, club materials, a business license, and a preliminary report on Greeley Recreation activities. Sidney Baldrige was very involved in agriculture, gardening, and the Greeley Gladiolus Festival.
