#### Administrative/Biographical History

#### **Eugene Koplitz**

Eugene Koplitz was a member of the Social Science Circle for thirty-four years and compiled information about the club's sphere of activity and the members who participated in social events. Dr. Koplitz received his bachelor's, master's, and doctorates from the University of Wisconsin. Later, he finished his post-doctoral study at Harvard University. Dr. Koplitz instructed at Artillery School Command in Ft. Sill, Oklahoma. He became a professor of Psychology at Colorado State College in Greeley, Colorado. He was the professor of Psychology, Counseling, and Guidance from the 1970s-1990s. He went on to write and participate in scholarly journals including, "Personality Differences Between Superior Honors Students and Average Students." Outside of Dr. Koplitz's educational career, he was a member of various organizations including the APG Council, SPATE, the American Psychological Association, the Colorado Education Association, the American Association, and the NCATE evaluation team at the University of Wichita Fall, Texas.

#### **Social Science Club**

The Social Science Circle was a Greeley club involved in humanitarian, social, and scientific topics. They frequently invited guest speakers and presented their own research at event plazas

or members' homes. Many of the Social Science Circle members were educators, doctors in specialized fields, and were well respected in the community. An example of topics discussed is John Weaver Jr.'s, "Therapeutic Value of the Arts." This presentation covered the use of various mediums of art as psychologically useful for all members of society.

## Want to Know Club (W.T.K.)

Many members of the Social Science Circle club, like Leslie Dae Lindou, participated in the W.T.K. club. This Greeley organization discussed similar topics; although, focused on politics, religion, and governmental issues. An example of the topics discussed is the 1946 article, "Oriental 'Sweden' Possible, if Mac Decrees Enforced." This presentation was about the subjugation of Japanese citizens and the quieted protests of the time under a dictatorship, and how the United Nations could become involved.
