Administrative/Biographical History

Biographical note on Archibald Lacy Camp Junior

Archibald Lacy Camp was born to Archibald Lacy Camp Senior and Cornelia Watson Camp on October 26, 1855 in Madison, Georgia. When he was 18, he moved to Greeley with his father and step- mother, Marietta Houston Sayers Camp. After working with his uncle, William J. Camp, in the freighting business, he returned to Georgia. In 1875, Archibald married Carrie Carroll in Georgia. Together they had five children, Archibald Lacy Camp III, Cather E. Camp, James Levy Camp, Mattie Barbara Camp Pinney, and Elizabeth Caroline Camp Winters. In 1880 Archibald and Carrie returned to Colorado where he started farming just northeast of Greeley. After trying his hand at farming, Archibald switched to breeding horses and in turn started the Red Bird Stock Farm. One of the most noticeable horses he bred was Weld County's first fast trotter named Red Bird. Archibald died on December 25, 1923 in Greeley.

Biographical note on Eloise Camp Arnold

Eloise Camp Arnold was born on February 28, 1911 to James Levy Camp and Mary Catherine McHale Camp. In August, 1928 she married Joseph Jacob Arnold in Fort Collins. Together they had one son named Gerald Arnold. Starting in 1945 Eloise worked for Weld County Garage. Eloise died on August 3, 1975 in Greeley.
