Administrative/Biographical History

Green-Heath Families The Green and Heath families came together through the marriage of William E. Green and Mary E. Heath.

Anna Maria Vincent Green (1836-1913). Born on November 24, 1836 in Franklin, Pennsylvania, Anna Vincent married William M. Green in 1864. They moved to Greeley as Union Colonists in May of 1870. Anna had four children, Mary E. Green Rice, Franklin J. Green, Kate Green Atkinson, and William E. Green, as well as adopted daughter Minnie Rigney Markle. Anna died in August 1913.

William McIntosh Green (1833-1899). Born on December 2, 1833 in Cooperstown, Pennsylvania, William Green served six months in the Union Army in the Civil War. He married Anna Vincent in 1864. They moved to Greeley together as Union Colonists in May 1870. They had four children, Mary E. Green Rice, Franklin J. Green, Kate Green Atkinson, and William E. Green, and one adopted daughter, Minnie Rigney Markle. He farmed and lived on 160 acres about eight miles from Greeley until January 1899 when he became too ill to live outside the city. He died on March 16, 1899.

William E. Green (1873-1924). Born on March 14, 1873 in Greeley, Colorado, William Edgar 'Ed' Green was the son of William M. and Anna M. Green. He worked as a farmer and stockman in the Greeley area. He had a business partnership with William H. Rice. On July 14, 1906, William married Mary E. Heath in Greeley. They had one daughter, Helen, who died at the age of four. William died on June 23, 1924 from complications of appendicitis.

Mary E. Heath Green (1877-1969). Born on August 25, 1877 in New Baltimore, Michigan, Mary E. Heath Green was the daughter of Henry P. and Emma Dennis Heath, and moved to Greeley with her parents in 1879. Mary married William E. Green on July 14, 1906 in Greeley. They had one daughter, Helen, who died at the age of four. Mary died on May 11, 1969.

Emma Dennis Heath (1852-1937). Emma was the daughter of Andrew and Mary B. Dennis, born in 1852. Emma married Henry Preston Heath in 1873 in Michigan and moved to Greeley in 1879. They had three children, Herbert G. Heath, Edith V. Heath, and Mary E. Heath Green. She was a member of the Greeley Garden Club, Daughters of the American Revolution, Eastern Star, Rebekahs, and the New Century Club.

Henry Preston Heath (1850-1907). Born on September 8, 1850 in New York, Henry Preston Heath grew up primarily in Michigan. He married Emma Dennis there in 1873. They moved to Greeley in 1879. He worked in real estate and was an organizer for the Woodmen of the World, a member of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, and a member and former Grand Chancellor for the Knights of Pythias. His three children were Herbert G. Heath, Edith V. Heath, and Mary E. Heath Green. He died on February 16, 1907 when thrown from his horse.

Edith Vera Heath (1875-1952). Born in 1875 in New Baltimore, Michigan to Henry Preston and Emma Dennis Heath. Edith graduated from the Colorado State Teachers College (now the University of Northern Colorado) in 1914 with an AB degree in elementary education. She taught a total of 43 years, 35 of which were at Greeley public schools. Heath Middle School in Greeley is named after Edith. Edith was a member of several clubs including the Daughters of the American Revolution, Delta Kappa Gamma, and American Association of University Women.
