Brief Bio of Donor, Ruth Stanley and Donor, Helen Stanley

Ruth E. Method Stanley (1905-2002) was born, Ruth E. Method on November 17, 1905 and died July 13, 2002. She grew up in Decatur, Nebraska and moved to New Raymer, Colorado when she was 13. She graduated from New Raymer High School in 1924. In 1925, she married Vern Stanley with whom she had five children. Ruth was the Post Master at Keota, Colorado from 1952 until her retirement in 1972.

Helen Method Newton was the daughter of Ruth Stanley's son, Don. She collected stamps for a period of time in her life. Knowing that, Ruth would periodically send her stamps and cancelled postmarked envelopes.

Scope and Content

During the years of 1971 and 1974, Ruth Method Stanley sent postmarked envelopes to her niece, Helen, her grand-niece Lillian, and her brother, Harold. Helen collected these mailings and donated the collection to the Greeley City Museums in 2018.

This collection consists of 35 stamped, postmarked, envelopes, cancelled with the Keota, Colorado stamp and 10 letters sent to family members. Also included in this collection are two miscellaneous cards, one describing the purpose of cancellations and one postcard also stamped with the Keota cancellation stamp.
