#### Administrative/Biographical History

The Want To Know Club, commonly referred to as WTK, was founded on January 21, 1890 by a group of Greeley women dedicated to the study and sharing of knowledge; initially pertaining to current local, state, national, and international conditions, events, and progress, later topics included cultural studies as well.

WTK was the first Woman's Club organized in Greeley, and in 1893, became a member of the General Federation of Women's Clubs. WTK Club continues as of the writing of this finding aid in 2022. Membership is all female and limited to 35 active members. New members are by invitation.

Currently, WTK meets twice monthly on Wednesdays for 16 meetings beginning in late September, with adjustments made for holidays. In addition to 35 active members, both associate and honorary status expands club numbers. Current bylaws call for active members to provide annual papers on assigned topics for 25 years to gain honorary member status.

There are a number of songs associated with the club, including the "Want To Know" song written by Mr. Oliver Howard. The tune is to the song "Scatter Seeds of Kindness". There is a reference in the song to a "circle of seven times five" which is likely a reference to the club active membership number. A motto of "New occasions teach new duties" is found printed on the annual yearbooks. The quote is from a song whose lyrics come from the poet James Russell Lowell.
