Administrative/Biographical History

The Masons in Colorado

The first Masonic meeting in Colorado was November 3rd, 1858, in the eastern foothills of the Rocky Mountains. In 1959, this founding group of Masonic men received permission from the Grand Lodge of Kansas to meet as Auraria Lodge in Denver. This was rechartered as the Denver Lodge No. 5 in 1861. Colorado's second charter came into the territory, also from Kansas, for Golden City Lodge in October 1860. In 1861, the Grand Lodge of Nebraska chartered Summit Lodge at Parksville and then Rocky Mountain Lodge at Gold Hill. These three lodges met at Golden City in 1861 and formed the Grand Lodge of Colorado. Colorado Freemasons raise funds for high school band camp scholarships, college and vocational educational grants, and Colorado Teacher of the Year awards. They also jointly support the Robert Russell Eastern Star Masonic Retirement and Assisted Living Center in Denver. In present day Colorado, the Grand Lodge of Colorado is comprised of more than 100 lodges with more than 5,000 brothers across the state.

In Greeley: In 1870, a group of Greeley Masons was granted a dispensation to operate a lodge. The charter was granted on September 26, 1871, to Occidental Lodge No. 20. A building at 7th Street and 8th Avenue was built under a lease agreement and destroyed by fire in 1883. The

group met in the Greeley Opera House building from 1913 through 1927. In 1907 the group voted to organize the Greeley Masonic Temple Association for the purpose of erecting or acquiring a building for a Masonic Temple. The capitalization was \$50,000 in 500 shares of \$100 each. A variety of other groups including other Masons, Knights Templar, and Eastern Star groups acquired stock in the Association. The Lodge occupied six distinct locations during its development, the cornerstone for the Greeley Masonic Temple having been laid in 1927. In 1969 the ownership of the building was restructured, with a nonprofit corporation, the Masonic Building Corporation of Greeley.

To satisfy the demands of a growing population, the Masons also established a presence outside Greeley. The Windsor Lodge No. 69 was instituted in 1887 and operated independently until 1986, when it was consolidated with Occidental Lodge #20.

The Masonic Lodge in Eaton was formed in 1899 and chartered in 1900, under the name of Abdallah Lodge No. 109. In 1906, its name was changed to Eaton Lodge No. 109. The Eaton Lodge never had a Temple of its own, meeting instead in rented quarters.

Membership in fraternal orders has waned regionally. Masons' lodges in smaller communities have closed, and Greeley's Masonic Lodge has become the repository for records and members from Eaton and Windsor. In 2015, the Masonic Temple in Greeley was sold, and the group merged with the Masonic Lodge in Fort Collins. The Greeley Masonic Temple remains a registered historical landmark building on the National Register of Historic Places.

Shriners International

In 1870 a group of 13 Masons met regularly at Knickerbocker Cottage in New York City. This group proposed forming a new fraternity for Masons, based on the tenets of Freemasonry but with the added elements of fun and fellowship. The name of this new fraternity was the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine. The fraternity's first official meeting was in 1871, with a meeting in 1872 establishing the first chapter, Mecca Shriners. Today, there are more than 195 chapters in countries around the world. In the late 1900s and early 2000s, the fraternity was referred to as Shriners of North America, given that chapters were in the US and Canada. In 2010, a resolution was passed to replace the name with Shriners International.

Shriners have always been known for their philanthropic efforts across the country. In 1919, the Imperial Potentate Freeland Kendrick proposed establishing a hospital to provide medical care at no cost to children with orthopedic conditions. A committee explored the idea and concluded there should not be just one hospital but an entire healthcare system throughout North America. The first hospital was opened in Shreveport, Louisiana in 1922. Today the system consists of hospitals, clinics, outpatient centers and telehealth sites. Shriners Children's specialties have expanded to burn care, spinal cord injury rehabilitation, cleft lip and palate, sports injury care and rehabilitation services.

In Colorado, the El Jebel Shriners is based in Denver. The Freemasons who founded the Grand Lodge of Colorado later dispensed the El Jebel Shrine Center on December 1, 1887, and chartered on June 25, 1888. In present day, El Jebel has 38 active units and clubs with 18

committees supporting the Shrine Center. El Jebel maintains an active membership with the Central States Shrine Association.

International Order of the Rainbow Girls

The Order of the Rainbow for Girls was founded in McAlester, Oklahoma in 1922 by the Reverend W. Mark Sexson, a Christian minister, Past Grand Master of Masons, and Past Grand Patron, Order of the Eastern Star in Oklahoma. It was created for young women whose fathers were members of the Masonic Lodge, and their friends, however today any girl who is interested in joining Rainbow Girls is welcome.

Rainbow quickly spread with assemblies instituted in Arkansas, Texas, Mississippi and Washington before the end of 1922. In 1924, Rainbow began in New York state, and now can be found in 47 states and 12 countries. Today there are more than 850 assemblies across the world that have bimonthly meetings.

Rainbow Girls volunteer for their community and travel around the world, visiting other clubs and making friends. They gather invaluable life skills that help them become the best daughter, sister, student and friend they can be. Rainbow is a non-profit, service-oriented organization that teaches girls three basic virtues: Faith in a Supreme Being and other people; having Hope in all that they do; and Charity towards others. The seven Colorado of the Rainbow are used to represent seven teachings that each member receives on her journey toward the pot of gold.

There are three stages of Rainbow Girls. The Young Ones are ages 8-10 and called Pledges. They cannot become a full Rainbow Girl until age 11, however they are encouraged to participate in many activities including charity work, installations, and other assembly activities. The Pledges are mentors by “big sister” relationships. The Busy Bees are age 11-20 and are official Rainbow Girls. These women and girls are involved in every aspect of the organization. At this age, they can be elected to hold office, travel locally or globally, conduct speaking engagements, oversee charity projects, and participate in all facets of Assembly work. Finally, The Advisors are active members over the age of 20 and make up the International Rainbow Alumni Association. These women are respected mentors and help to guide the younger girls through their journey to reaching their “pot of gold”. They provide networking opportunities while reconnecting current members with the Rainbow heritage.

To join the Rainbow Girls, an application, home visit, and then formal vote occur. New members and their families participate in an Initiation Ceremony. Rainbow members have a dress code that applies to members and adults. Formal meetings and open ceremonies of Rainbow can be found in a book called Ritual.

In 2015, a statement by the Supreme Executive Board of the International Order of the Rainbow Girls was accepted regarding the admission of transgender girls and women to the Order. This statement includes a zero-tolerance policy for harm and harassment and will consider applicants on a case-by-case basis with the priority of ensuring the child is living culturally as a girl and is recognized by family, school, community, and medical providers.

In Colorado

The 94th Grand Assembly of Colorado is anticipated to occur June 15-18, 2023, in Loveland Colorado. Currently there are six assemblies and three districts across the state. Assemblies are in Colorado Springs, Littleton, Grand Junction, Monte Vista, and Golden, Gunnison.

Colorado's Rainbow Girls dress code was revised as recently as 2020. The Covenant, the Colorado Rainbow Girls publication, is available online from 1963-1966 and from 2016-2022. The Ritual handbook was updated in 2012, 2018 and again in 2020. As recent as 2022, an online initiative to digitally map and connect over social media with all Rainbow Girls around the world has been launched. ZeeMaps visualization shows Greeley #6, La Salle #91, Johnstown #82, Eaton #44, Windsor #58, Loveland #3 have all been mapped in addition to hundreds more across Colorado.

In Greeley, Greeley Assembly No. 6 is a charitable organization, granted tax-exempt status by the IRS in July 1942. Their meetings were held at the Greeley Masonic Center.

Order of the Knights Templar

The Order of the Knights Templar is a Masonic organization in the York Right of Freemasonry. The Knights Templar is a Christian-oriented fraternal organization whose main activities involve fund-raising for the support of Masonic-related youth organizations and other charities.

The Knights Templar originated during the medieval era, founded in 1118AD and was a large organization of devout Christians who carried out the important mission of protecting European travelers visiting sites in the Holy Land while also carrying out military operations. The group was named for the Temple Mount in Jerusalem. Today they exist to spread Christianity and to follow the Biblical teachings while honoring the traditions of Templar history. Presently, the USA division of the Knights Templar are Frontline Partners with Global Christian Relief (formerly Open Doors USA).

In the US, the Knights Templar is divided into six regions called Priories. These are the Priories of King David, St. Joan of Arc, St. Sebastian, St. Michael the Archangel, St. Luke, and the Holy Trinity. Each Priorie is overseen and led by a Prior. All Templars, regardless of rank, follow the twenty-four virtues of knighthood and believe in the three creeds.

Once a fully vetted member, Templars can attend the Templar Academie of America. There they learn Basic Training, Templar History, Virtues of Knighthood, Leadership and Ministry, and Protocols.

Colorado is a part of the Priory of St. Joan of Arc and has the Knights Templar Association of Colorado. The Colorado Association focuses on promoting the Grand Commandery of Colorado, through providing planning assistance to Colorado Commanderies for Christmas, Easter, and Ascension Day observances. Additionally, they promote the Knights Templar Association Banner Program through several award programs and perpetuate the Traveling Sword Program which emphasizes visitations by Commanderies.

Current Colorado assemblies include Akron, Grand Junction, and Angel on the Rio. Partnerships exist between the Grand Junction Masonic Center and the Telluride Council #10 with the Colorado Grand and Gunnison Rivers assemblies. Great Plains partnership includes Cheyenne Masonic Temple members, Wheatland York Rite, and Harmony Chapter No. 53 Order of the Eastern Star. The Knights Templar Educational Foundation of the Grand Encampment was established in January 1952 in Westminster, followed by the Knights Templar chapter in Grand Junction, Sterling, Fort Collins, and Greeley all in January 1964.

In Greeley, the Knights Templar of the United States of America chartered the Greeley York Rite Bodies in January 1964 by Donald T Harris and meetings were hosted at 2532 9th Avenue. In November 1972, additional chartering was established through the Royal and Select Masters of Colorado for the York Rite Bodies of Colorado, again by Donald T Harris, and located at 3301 W 23rd Street.

Order of the Eastern Star

The tenets of the Order of Eastern Star are based on the teachings of Brother Rob Morris, who became a Master Mason in Oxford, Mississippi in 1849. The Order of Eastern Star is now the largest fraternal order in the world to which both men and women may belong, and it embodies deep religious beliefs and spiritual values. The initiatory degrees of the Order are given to members at ceremonies that focus on selected women of the Bible who demonstrate heroic conduct and high moral values. The five degrees use these examples to teach the Masonic principles of charity, truth, and loving kindness. Men who are Master Masons in good standing of a regular Lodge of the Masonic Fraternity can join, as can women who are relatives of past or present Master Masons in good standing of a regular Lodge of the Masonic Fraternity and have reached the age of 18. Women can also join if they are majority members of the International Order of the Rainbow for Girls or Job's Daughters International who have reached the age of 18.

In Colorado, the Garden City #3 Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star can be found in collection 2006.50.

Scope and Content This collection contains correspondences, financial records, legal documents, meeting records, membership documents, membership rules, photographs, and objects from within the Masonic Order including the Masonic Lodge, Shriners, International Order of the Rainbow for Girls, Rainbow Mother's Circle, Commandery of the Knights Templar, and Order of the Eastern Star. A complete list of individual lodges, charters, and assemblies as well as individual members can be found in the appendices of this learning aid.
